- B. Showmanship Classes (No Entry Fee Required) (Age as of September 1, 2020) Show starts at 9:00 AM
 - 1. Pee Wee Showmanship (7 years old and under) Trophies only

2. Showmanship (14 - 18 Years Old) 1st - \$20 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10 3. Showmanship (8 - 13 Years Old) 1st - \$20 2nd - \$15 3rd - \$10

- G. ENTRY FEES are \$10.00 per animal received by <u>Friday, May 28th.</u> No entry fee for Classes 1, 2 or 3. LATE FEE \$5.00/head for all entries not received by May 28th and for all entries submitted on show day
- H. Entries are subject to Texas Animal Health Commission regulations and inspections.
- I. \$10 per animal clean-up charge for Saturday night layover.
- J. Exhibitors may arrive at Fairgrounds on Friday, June 4th from 3:00 to 8:00 p.m.
