2023-2024 Guidelines of the Washington County 4-H County Council

- Council Officers are required to attend the District 11 Leadership Lab (June 14-16, 2023) and Prestige Leadership Conference (July 20-21, 2023) before they begin their term of office.
- Officers must have been in 4-H for two years and must be at least 14 years old as of August 31, 2023.
- Officers will attend all County Council meetings and 4-H programs/functions.
- Officers should arrive to 4-H meetings and events at least 15 minutes early.
- If an officer is aware that he/she cannot attend a meeting, they will contact the 4-H County Extension Agent and the County Council Chairman prior to the absence (preferably a week in advance).
- Officers should serve as role models to other 4-H'ers.
- Council Officers will assist in the planning, coordination, and execution of County Wide Meeting, One Day 4-H, County Camp, Washington County Ag Day, and Family Night.
