Thank you for making an inquiry about the *LaNell Seeker 4-H Memorial Scholarship*. The information below explains in detail requirements needed in addition to the application.

1. Applicant for *LaNell Seeker 4-H Memorial Scholarship* must
 - a. Be involved in Washington County 4-H for minimum of 3 years.
 - b. Be a resident of Washington County.
 - c. Be involved in community, church, civic entities.
 - d. Be academically successful.
2. Applicant *must* intend to further his/her education and training beyond his/her high school diploma at an accredited university, college or trade school.
3. Applicant *must be a graduate of a Washington County High School or accredited Home School, Class of 2023.*
4. Amount of Scholarship will be \$1000.00. Money will be awarded upon receipt of proof of registration for classes and previous semester grades showing minimum of 2.0 GPA. You have up to three years to request your scholarship payment. This payment will be mailed directly to the school unless other arrangements are made. If no prior arrangements are made and money is not used, money will revert back to the scholarship fund.
5. Copy of High School Transcript should be attached to application.
6. Application deadline is June 15, 2023.
7. Application is to be submitted to Washington County 4-H AgriLife Office.
8. All applications become the property of the Scholarship Committee, whose decision is final.
